

## COOKIE POLICIES

The data controller, Patrolline Società Cooperativa, pursuant to articles 13-14 of EU Reg. 2016/679, with registered office in Via Cesare Cantù, 15/c, 22031 – Albavilla (Co) (Mo), VAT IT03581890138, as Data Controller, below provides all the information on services used by the site that can install cookies and the necessary information on how to manage your preferences regarding them.

### What are cookies and what are they for?

A cookie is a simple text file that is stored on your computer or mobile device by a website server and that only that server will be able to retrieve or read its contents. It contains some anonymous information and allows the website to remember some data.

There are different types of cookies, which can be defined as follows:

**Technical cookies (which DO NOT require your consent)** : they are necessary for the site to function and allow you to access its functions ( *navigation cookies* ) and are mostly session cookies. We can also use *functional cookies* that allow you to save your preferences and settings, improving your browsing experience on our site (e.g. remember you as a registered user of the site when you select the "Remember me" function; connect you to the section of the site in your language possibly chosen or based on the country from which you access; remember your preferences in terms of accepting or not profiling cookies). To guarantee their functionality and to be able to remember your preferences, these cookies are not deleted when the browser is closed; however, they have a maximum predefined duration (up to a maximum of 2 years) and after the predefined period of time they are deactivated automatically. These cookies and the data they collect are not used for any other purpose. Your consent is not required to install technical cookies; we proceed with their installation automatically following access to the site or your request for certain features (eg by selecting "remember me"). You can always decide to disable them at any time by changing your browser settings. However, in this case, you may not be able to view our site correctly.

**Profiling cookies (which require your CONSENT):** Our site uses so-called cookies. *profiling cookies* that can only be installed with your prior consent.

The cookies defined as profiling by the Guarantor for the protection of personal data may include various categories of cookies, including advertising profiling cookies, retargeting cookies, social cookies and analytical cookies which are not limited to aggregate statistical analyses.

(i) Advertising profiling cookies: they create user profiles to let you view advertising messages in line with the preferences you show while browsing the Internet; (ii) Retargeting cookies : they send you advertising to offer you products similar to those in which you have expressed interest (for example, showing you the products you have viewed on our site when you browse affiliated sites), or they allow you to measure the effectiveness of a advertising campaign by us or by third parties; (iii) Analytical cookies: they keep track of the choices you make on the site and of your navigation to carry out statistical analyzes by us and by third parties, keeping track of your preferences and your online

behavior and to offer you personalized messages; (iv) Social cookies: the site also allows some social networks (for example, Facebook, Twitter) to install their own cookies using their plug-ins. These cookies are managed directly by these third parties and can also be used to display advertising messages on other sites in line with your preferences.

## Legal basis

For technical cookies, the legal basis lies in the execution of a contract or pre-contractual measures (Article 6.b of the GDPR) as they are necessary to make the site and the service requested usable by users. The use of these cookies does not require your consent. The use of profiling cookies (including non-anonymised analytics ) can only take place with your consent, which constitutes the legal basis for the processing of data collected through these cookies, in compliance with the provisions of art. 6.a of the GDPR. The consent can be provided by you or revoked at any time by operating directly in the appropriate area present in this document or accessible from the banner provided when accessing the site. Failure to provide data following your lack of consent for these cookies has no consequence for the purposes of browsing the site and its use, but makes it impossible to offer you advertising messages on services and goods in line with your preferences and your real interests expressed in the context of your web browsing.

## Is personal data transferred outside the European Union (EU)?

Some data collected by cookies may be transferred abroad to locations outside the European Union. This transfer will in any case be carried out in compliance with the guarantees prescribed by the GDPR for this type of activity (Articles 45 to 49). Such as, for example: transfer to companies located in countries for which the existence of personal data protection guarantees comparable to those of the GDPR is recognized (Countries in White List); or to companies with which specific contractual clauses for the protection of personal data approved by the European Commission or by the Guarantor Authority have been signed, or which adopt binding company rules approved by the Guarantor Authority; or when the transfer is necessary for the execution of the contract concluded with the interested party or to execute your request; or it takes place on the basis of specific derogations provided for by the GDPR. It is possible to obtain further information, upon request, from the Data Controller at the contacts indicated above.

## How long is the data kept for?

The retention period of the data collected through the use of cookies and other tracking tools is indicated in the lists of cookies used by this site available above.

### **Who can know your data? Who do we communicate them to?**

The data will be processed by personnel appointed and instructed by Patrolline , specifically authorized pursuant to article 4, paragraph 10 of EU Regulation 2016/679, and designated pursuant to art. 2 quaterdecies of Legislative Decree 101/2018, with procedures, technical and IT tools suitable for protecting the confidentiality and security of your personal data. The data collected through cookies may be used by collaborators authorized by the Data Controller, such as for example those in charge of site maintenance and management, marketing and administration. They may also be used by any third parties (service, infrastructure, IT providers involved in the management and supervision of the site and the like) who operate on behalf of the Data Controller and have been duly appointed as data processors in accordance with the provisions of Article 28 of the GDPR . With your consent, they may also be used by third parties who install their cookies on the owner's website. The interested party may request a complete and updated list of the subjects appointed as data processors by contacting one of the contacts indicated.

### **What are your rights?**

We remind you that in relation to your Personal Data you can exercise your rights towards the Data Controller, pursuant to articles 15 and following. of EU Regulation 2016/679, i.e. you will be able to obtain confirmation of the existence of your personal data and request their communication in an intelligible form. You will also have the right to obtain the updating, rectification, integration and cancellation of data or limitation of treatment. Finally, you will have the right to object, in whole or in part, for legitimate reasons, to the processing of your personal data, even if pertinent to the purpose of the collection. You will have the right to exercise the right to data portability and to lodge a complaint with the Supervisory Authority.

### **How to control or delete cookies**

By choosing to refuse cookies, the user may not be able to use all the site's features.

It is possible to block cookies through the banner displayed when accessing the site or by following the instructions provided by the browser (usually found in the "Help", "Tools" or "Edit" menu). Disabling a cookie or a category of cookies does not delete them from the browser. Therefore, this operation must be performed directly in the browser.

If you want to delete, disable or restore the cookies on your computer, you can use the cookie configuration pages made available by any third-party content providers, or through the user's browser options.
